You will have access to a variety of online resources which will enable you to develop an understanding of the Health Care Sector and enhance your skills in Maths and English.

If you require additional support, this can be provided by a Functional Skills Trainer at our training centre based in Fareham.

The Flying Start Programme is designed to enhance your employability skills by developing your knowledge of the Health Care Sector through the following modules:

- The role of the Health and Social Care worker
- Underpinning knowledge in Health and Social Care
- Duty of Care
- Understand Safeguarding and Prevent
- Communication within Health Care
- Health and Safety
- Employment Legislation - Rights and Responsibilities

Completion of the programme may also enhance progression opportunities into the Health Care Sector. Roles within this sector can include:

Eligibility:

- Must not be undertaking other government funded training programmes
- Do not have a Maths or English qualification at Grade C, 4 or above
- Eligible to live and work in England
- Aged 19 or over at date of registration
- A citizen of a country within the European Economic Area (EEA)
- Non-EEA citizen may be eligible if they have permission granted by the UK government to live in the UK, which is not for educational purposes, and have been ordinarily resident in the UK for at least the previous three years
