

Entry Requirements:

- Candidates should already be working as an Assistant Buyer or Buyer or as an Assistant Merchandiser or Merchandiser.
- The entry requirement for this apprenticeship will be decided by each employer but may typically be five GCSEs at grade C or higher.

Overview:

The Assistant Buyer and Assistant Merchandiser qualification is a great way to learn and implement new skills, knowledge and behaviours within an Assistant Buyer/Buyer or Assistant Merchandiser/Merchandiser role.

This apprenticeship is suitable for Assistant Buyers or Assistant Merchandisers who typically work within the retail sector; however, this could be across a range of different companies; for example, trading through stores, exclusively online and those who operate through a variety of channels.

Key responsibilities are likely to include; understand the brand and customer in order to source, select, maintain and deliver the right products to meet demand and business objectives; use effective business forecasting, risk and opportunity analysis, creativity and business insight to anticipate and shape customer demand and market trends.
